

What is Community Supported Agriculture?

In brief, CSA is a system of food distribution based on trust between the member and the farmer. By purchasing a share in advance, you (the member) provide us with working capital and a guaranteed market for our produce. We will in turn, provide you with produce grown to the best of our ability. Because of a guaranteed market we are able to offer a discount to you. The members and the farmers become partners in caring for our small family farm.

The Farmers - A Brief History

Originally from Williamstown, Mass., we came to Pownal, Vt. in 1984 in search of a homesteading way of life. However, we quickly fell in love with the growing of all things green and, at the same time, recognized a growing need in our community for fresh, local, organic produce. In 1989, Wildstone Farm then became one of a small number of certified organic farms in the State of Vermont. In 2015 we will be celebrating our 31st year on our farm in Pownal and our 26th year of organic certification. It continues to be a productive and rewarding journey.



On Farm CSA at Wildstone Farm

Our on farm CSA is for 20 weeks, June thru October. Each week you pick up your share which is based on what is available that week. The on farm CSA share represents the greatest value. Also, we hope you will take the opportunity of getting to know your farm and farmers while you're here.

Farmers' Market Share CSA

Our farmers' market share CSA uses a debit-style system. As a member you can purchase a share which is redeemable for whatever we sell at our farmers' market stand in Bennington. Your account is updated with each purchase. Shares must be used up by the end of the calendar year; we will not carry balances over into the next calendar year.

Northern Berkshire Summer CSA

New this year!

Based on our successful Northern Berkshire Winter CSA, we are excited to announce our Northern Berkshire Summer CSA. A pre-packed CSA share is delivered to a central northern Berkshire location for 20 weeks from early June thru October. The cost of the share is **\$515**.

To keep the cost as low as possible we are offering only one size. Worried that you won't use an entire share each week? Consider splitting the cost with a friend or family member and you both can benefit from the bounty.

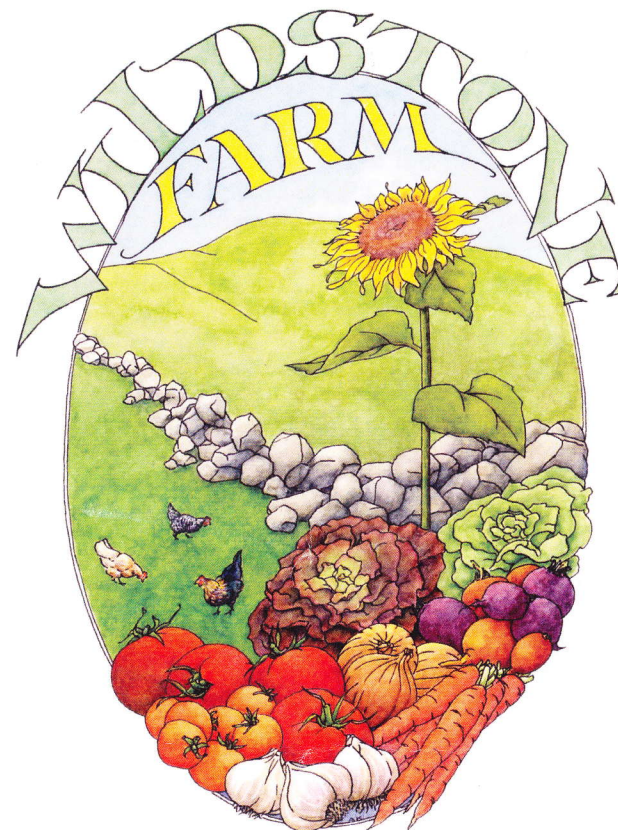
