What is Community Supported Agriculture?

CSA is a system of food distribution based on trust between the member and the farmer. By making your purchases in advance, you (the member) provide us with working capital and a guaranteed market for our produce. We will, in turn, provide you with the produce of your choice, grown to the best of our ability. The members and the farmers become partners in caring for our small family farm.

Who We Are: A Tale of Two Farmers

We both were raised in nearby Williamstown and come from several generations of Williamstown farm families. In 1984 after searching for a place to raise our family we came to Pownal and began to homestead. Homesteading turned into market gardening on a large scale when we recognized a growing need in our community for fresh local organic produce. In 1989 Wildstone Farm became the first farm in Bennington County to become certified organic. Consider joining us in 2019 as we proudly celebrate our 35th year here in Pownal and our 30th year of organic certification by Vermont Organic Farmers.

Receive your CSA share for 20 weeks, June thru October. Shares will be available for pick up at the farm Tuesdays 3-6pm and Fridays 3-6pm. In addition there will be shares delivered on Tuesdays to drop off sites in Williamstown and North Adams after 3:30pm. With on-line ordering you will be able to customize your share, purchase extras, schedule a vacation without losing a week's share, etc. Presently we have pick up sites at in Williamstown and at Storey Publishing, Louison House and Berkshire Kettle Bells in North Adams. **Want to host a Work Place CSA Pick Up Site:** We require a minimum of 5 shares, someone to host and be on our delivery route.. We will deliver to Bennington also. Contact us for details.
